St. Francis Parish is happy to announce that scholarships are available for High School Seniors enrolling as full-time students in an accredited institution of higher education (College, Vocational or Technical). The funds have been made available via the **Dorothy & Wilhelmine Ratermann Trusts** for higher education scholarships and are awarded in their memory. Scholarships are intended to benefit students in “financial limbo.” By this we mean students whose families have mid-level incomes, and thus earn too little to pay for college outright, but earn too much to qualify for need-based grants or scholarships. Amounts are variable, but a scholarship of \$2,000 is not an unreasonable expectation. Primary consideration is given to members of St. Francis Parish, secondary given to Aviston area residents. Scholarships are based on need, community and Church involvement, satisfactory academic performance, letters of recommendation, a short essay and an interview. Are you up for the challenge?
